He graduated from the Medical University of Gdansk in 1975. He completed his second degree of specialization in general surgery in 1982. He defended his doctorate on the disease of the upper gastrointestinal tract in 1990. He earned his doctorate nine years later.

Immediately after graduation, he started working in the District Hospital in Toruń. From 1976 to 1989 he was the assistant in the General Surgery Department. In the same year he started lecturing at the Medical Academy in Bydgoszcz. Three years later he became the deputy director for health care at the Toruń hospital.

Since 2003, he has been the head of the Department and Clinic of General, Gastroenterological and Oncological Surgery at the Nicolaus Copernicus University Medical College in Toruń. He is the chief physician in the hospital in Bielany.

He is a pioneer of endoscopy and laparoscopic operations in Toruń. He is the author and initiator of numerous scientific works.

He was awarded the Gold Cross of Merit. Since 2012 he has been a regional consultant for general surgery.
